



**Request for additional qualifications or honours to be added to the Veterinary Council Register of Veterinarians**

Qualifications gained in addition to those required for registration as a veterinarian, may be submitted to the Council for inclusion on the Register of Veterinarians. To be approved for inclusion on the Register the additional qualification must:

- have relevance to veterinary practice; and
- have been awarded following successful completion of a course of training or study by a body recognised by the Council.

Civilian and military decorations may also be submitted for inclusion on the Register of Veterinarians.

Requests for additional qualifications or honours to be added to the Register need to be accompanied by a certified copy of the qualification document or evidence of the award of the honour. The copy of the qualification document must be certified as a true copy of the original by a Notary Public or Justice of the Peace (refer to the Yellow Pages of the telephone directory for those in your area) or by a barrister or solicitor.
